A CI / TPRS workshop will show you how to make your classes more interesting and effective for your students. You will learn to teach with stories and various activities. The workshop is appropriate for beginners and returnees. Workshops consist of a lot of practice, which allows teachers to learn the necessary skills to be able to successfully teach using CI / TPRS. Come and learn CI / TPRS by teaching and being taught by Liam Printer, a very successful Spanish teacher who has been presenting in various conferences. This is a 1 day workshop. The workshop has an introduction to CI / TPRS, a demonstration and extensive practice. Teachers will practice various essential CI / TPRS skills, including asking repetitive questions, pacing, and how to make the stories interesting via personalization and asking for

"surprise" details from students. Teachers will be taught how to plan stories for their own classrooms. Teachers will also learn how to teach a story with student actors. The presenter will start with one sentence and practice adding additional sentences, one at a time. Liam will also demonstrate an extended reading, and reading and discussing the novels. Lastly, teachers will learn about grading and classroom management in a CI / TPRS classroom.
