BASKETBALL CAT. D BOYS TOURNAMENT RULES 10.03.12

TEAMS

- Only players born 1.9.1998 - 31.8.2000 are permitted to participate.
- 5 players with a maximum of 7 substitutes (i.e. teams of 12 maximum)

MATCHES

- 2 x 10 minute halves **with stop clock in the last 2 minutes.**
- 2 minute break between halves.
- 2 minutes overtime will be played if the match finishes with a draw. In the case of a draw at the end of overtime, extra time will be played using golden goal(basket).
- Normal FIBA rules apply.
- No zone defence as recommended by the Swiss Basketball Association.
- 1 timeout per half, plus 1 during overtime.
- Substitutions can be made directly with the referee, during appropriate times according to FIBA rules.
- 4th personal foul will result in exclusion from the match.
- 4th team foul and every foul after will result in 2 free throws, to be reset for each half.

PLACING

- Points will be awarded as follows: Win = 3 points, Loss = 1 point.
- Round robin draw (unless large number of teams enter in which case two pools will be made)– this means your team will play every other team once before the finals.
- In the event of a tie at the end of qualifying matches:
 - head to head results will be used,
 - if there is still a tie goal difference will determine final positions.
 - To avoid inflicting heavy losses on weaker teams goal differences will be restricted to +20.
