Please find enclosed the invitation and the rules for our basketball tournament that will take place on LGB Campus, 62 route de Chêne-1208 Geneva

1- Teams composition

Each team will be composed of 12 players born between 1st September 1997 and 31st August 1999. The completed team forms must be handed in to the tournament director during the coaches meeting. In accordance with SGIS policy, all coaches should be able to provide evidence of each player's date of birth if required.

2- Arrival and departure

A coach meeting will be held at 10.30 and the first game is scheduled to start at 11.00. As the playing schedule is tight, please make sure that your team is ready to start their game promptly.

Saturday will be dedicated to the group matches (2 groups of 4 or 5 teams). The beginnings of the matches are planned at 11.00 and the end between 17.30 and 18.00 depending on the teams playing.

Sunday will be dedicated to the play-off games between 09.00 and 11.15 and the final one around 11.30. The end of this tournament is planned between 12.30 and 13.00 at the latest.

3- Facilities

All the matches will take place on the Campus, in the same gymnasium that contains 2 fields in parallel. Changing rooms, showers and first aid will be available.

4- Referees and score tables

The matches will be officiated by referees from the Swiss Basketball Federation, the scores tables will be done by senior basketball players from our Campus within the CAS project.

5- Lunches

During the tournament, our PTA association will have a canteen with a variety of sandwiches (5 CHF), hot panini (5 CHF), snacks, cakes and drinks. The teams can then eat on the Campus during the day.

6- Places to stay if needed

There are a lot of hotels in Geneva, but be aware that at that period of the year there is the "Salon de l'Auto" and you need to book very quickly. In the area of the train station, there are several hotels, about 15 minutes from our Campus. Do not hesitate to contact me if needed.

7- Awards

The first placed team will receive a trophy and medals to keep, the second and third team will receive medals.

8- Fair-Play

As noted in the SGIS guideline, coaches, players and parents are expected to set a good example of fair-play and sportsmanship.

9- Tournament costs

The cost will be between 300/450 CHF depending on the number of teams.
