12.30 Introduction to Gordon Nunn Inter Soccer Representative.

Keith gave a detailed account of the June 2007 meeting in which primary school AD's. The group discussed adding clinics for SGIS schools using the company Inter Soccer. Two separate clinics that would be one in the fall term and one in the spring term.

The Primary working group's purpose is to add more Primary events to the SGIS calendar for Cat. 5 and Cat. 6.

Gordon Nunn gave a typical Clinic day with Inter Soccer

- 9 to 10 warm up and normal registration
- 10 to 10.30 player meet the coach
- 10.30 to 11 skills stations (motor skills, speed shooting, dribbling).
- 11-12 fun games and techniques
- Lunch
- 12.30 Confidence building, teamwork skills, interactive communication
- 12.45 Football competitions, juggling, speed shooting
- 13.15 Football tournament
- 15.15 Cool down and finish

Extrinsic rewards include medals, certificates, bags, and sweatbands.
Price CHF 60- 70 average cost per student.

12.40 Discussion about the administration concerns of using even more class time for sport

- Having the clinic on a Saturday would be a good solution

12.45 Inter sport billing procedures

- Inter Soccer is flexible on billing and able to receive payment from schools or directly from parents

12.47 Inter sport is available to come to individual schools

- Inter sport can come to individual schools to offer clinics

12.55 Looking at dates and venue for clinics

The first clinic cannot be on Oct. 6th. as no pitches are available.

Intersoccer are looking into finding a pitch on a different date.

- Venue to be determined
- JFK, and Le Rosey and St.Georges will be looking at facilities

13.10 Is this an SGIS sanctioned event?

- This will be a SGIS open invitational event
- Individual schools can decide how to advertise, transport and bill students

13.20 Coaching clinic for SGIS coaches through facilitated by Inter Soccer staff

- We will wait for a date when an FA official can be present
- The date is to be determined, Gordon Nunn from inter sport is looking into dates and staffing
- Schools can go to FA website and pay 48 pounds per internet course for coaching certificates
- Schools can use Firstmed a Swiss company to train and certify first aid coaches (www.firstmed.ch)
- Clinic would give coaches a 2 year FA certificate
